PART 3: JESUS IN THE SEVEN JEWISH FEASTS

Joel 1:¹¹ Be ashamed, you **farmers**, Wail, you **vinedressers**, For the **wheat and the barley**; Because the harvest of the field has perished. ¹² The **vine has dried up**, And the **fig tree has withered**; The **pomegranate tree**, the **palm tree** also, And the **apple tree**— **All the trees of the field are withered**; Surely **joy has withered** away from the sons of men.



¹³ **Gird yourselves and lament**, you **priests**; Wail, you who minister before the altar; Come, lie all night in **sackcloth**, You who minister to my God; For the grain offering and the drink offering are withheld from the house of your God. ¹⁴ **Consecrate a fast, call a sacred assembly; Gather the elders** And **all the inhabitants** of the land *Into* the house of the LORD your God, And cry out to the LORD. ¹⁵ **Alas for the day! For the day of the LORD is at hand; It shall come as destruction from the Almighty**

Leviticus 23:1-36

¹ And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying,

² "Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: **'The feasts of the LORD**, which you shall proclaim *to be* holy convocations, these *are* My feasts.

³ 'Six days shall work be done, but the seventh day *is* a Sabbath of solemn rest, a holy convocation. You shall do no work *on it*; *it is* the Sabbath of the LORD in all your dwellings.

⁴ **'These are the feasts of the LORD**, holy convocations which you shall proclaim at their appointed times.

I. PASSOVER: Leviticus 23:5

⁵ On the fourteenth *day* of the first month at twilight *is* the LORD'S Passover.

II. UNLEAVENED BREAD: Leviticus 23:6-8

⁶ And on the fifteenth day of the same month *is* the **Feast of Unleavened Bread to the LORD**; seven days you must eat unleavened bread. ⁷ On the first day you shall have a holy convocation; you shall do no customary work on it. ⁸ But you shall offer an offering made by fire to the LORD for seven days. The seventh day *shall be* a holy convocation; you shall do no customary work *on it*.

III. FIRSTFRUITS: Leviticus 23: 9-14

⁹ And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, ¹⁰ "Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: 'When you come into the land which I give to you, and reap its harvest, then you shall bring a sheaf of the **firstfruits** of your harvest to the priest.

IV. PENTECOST: Leviticus 23: 15-22

¹⁵ 'And you shall count for yourselves from the day after the Sabbath, from the day that you brought the sheaf of the wave offering: seven Sabbaths shall be completed.

¹⁶ Count **fifty days** to the day after the seventh Sabbath; then you shall offer a new grain offering to the LORD.



V. TRUMPETS: Leviticus 23:23-25

²³ Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying,

²⁴ "Speak to the children of Israel, saying: 'In **the seventh month, on the first day of the month**, you shall have a sabbath-rest, a memorial of **blowing of trumpets**, a holy convocation.

²⁵ You shall do no customary work on it; and you shall offer an offering made by fire to the LORD.' "

VI. ATONEMENT: Leviticus 23:26-32

²⁶ And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying: ²⁷ "Also **the tenth day of this seventh month** shall be the **Day of Atonement**. It shall be a holy convocation for you; you shall afflict your souls, and offer an offering made by fire to the LORD.

VII. TABERNACLES: Leviticus 23:33-42

³³ Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, ³⁴ "Speak to the children of Israel, saying: 'The **fifteenth day of this seventh month** shall be the **Feast of Tabernacles** for seven days to the LORD. ³⁵ On the first day there shall be a holy convocation. You shall do no customary work on it.

³⁶ For seven days you shall offer an offering made by fire to the LORD. On the eighth day you shall have a holy convocation, and you shall offer an offering made by fire to the LORD. It is a sacred assembly, and you shall do no customary work on it.
